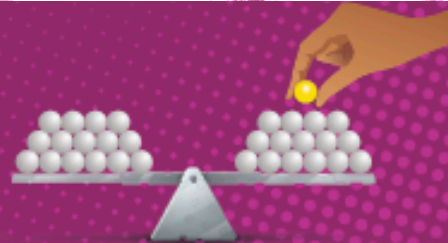

# Local Government & District Education Council Elections



## YOUR VOTE MATTERS!

May 11, 2026

Local Government, Rural District Advisory Committee and District Education Council elections will be held throughout the province on Monday, May 11, 2026, for the positions listed here.

## DATES & TIMES OF VOTING

### ADVANCE VOTING

Saturday, May 2  
Monday, May 4

### ELECTION DAY

Monday, May 11

Polls are open each day from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Bring your voter information card with you for faster service.

### RETURNING OFFICE VOTING

Starting April 20, electors have the option to vote at any of the returning offices in the province. The returning office can provide an elector with the ballot for a contest in any part of the province, where they are eligible to vote.

Starting March 23, the returning offices are open 6-days a week up to and including election day. The list of locations and contact information for the returning offices will be posted on our website once the election begins.



## QUALIFICATIONS TO VOTE

A person is qualified to vote in the election if they are:

- a Canadian citizen
- at least 18 years old by Election Day
- a resident of the Province for at least 40 days immediately before the election, and living in the local government, rural district, or school district on Election Day

## GETTING ON THE VOTERS LIST

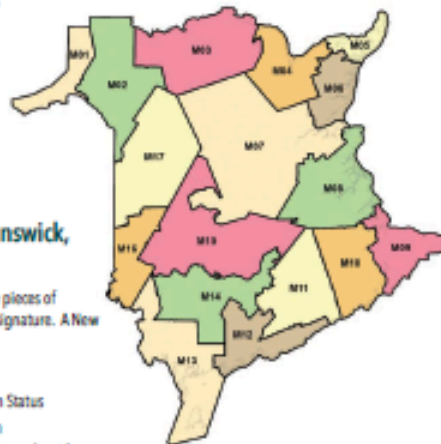
If you have voted in a previous election in New Brunswick, you may already be on the voters list.

To be added, you must meet the qualifications to vote and provide one or more pieces of identification that, in combination, show your name, current civic address and signature. A New Brunswick driver's licence contains all three and is ideal.

Other options include:

- a lease agreement, utility bills, Medicare card, student ID, Certificate of Indian Status
- any other documentation that provides the above three pieces of information
- having a friend on the voters list for your polling station vouch for your identity and residency
