TRADITIONAL IRISH APPLE CAKE

- 1 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 ½ tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- ¼ cup butter, softened
- ¼ cup white sugar
- 3 large eggs
- 2 TBSP milk
- 2 apples - peeled, cored, and thinly sliced

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F
Butter an 8-1/2x11-inch pan
Sift flour, baking powder, and cinnamon in a bowl. Beat butter & sugar together using an electric mixer until light and soft.
Beat in 1 egg & 1 TBSP of the flour mixture. Repeat twice more. Fold in two-thirds of the remaining flour. Stir in milk; fold in the rest of the flour.
Spread 1/2 the batter into the bottom of the prepared dish. Distribute apple slices on top and cover with remaining batter. Bake in the preheated oven for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 325 degrees. Continue baking until golden brown and firm to the touch, about 30 minutes more.
